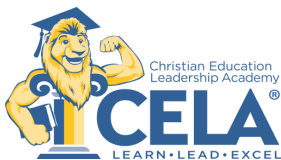

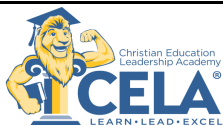

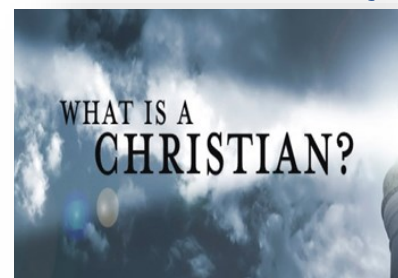
Please join us next week as we start our study of “What it means to be a Christian”. The 8th graders will be leading Chapel on 10/4. Everyone is welcome!

## 8th Grade Science

In 8th grade science, the students have been working hard to construct their “Egg Vehicles”. This is for the annual egg smash that demonstrates Newton’s Laws of Motion. The kids must keep their eggs safe and secure inside the vehicles, all while trying their best to inflict damage to their competitors vehicles and eggs. We focus on Newton’s 2nd law which is the law of Force & Acceleration. We also go in depth with the 3rd law which is known as the law of Action and Reaction.



## 6th/7th Grade Science

The 6th and 7th graders took some time in science to clean out the impurities in the gas lines of the Bunsen burners by making s’mores! This was a fun way to look at heat reactions with different compounds.



## 7th Grade Social Studies

The 7th grade social studies class has been learning about how feudalism worked in Medieval Europe. They created “castles” and acted out feudalism in the pictures below.



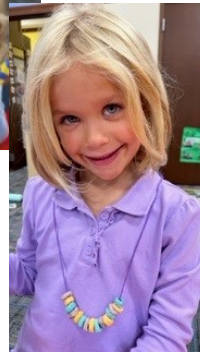
## 3K Science

3K completed their first science experiment mixing primary paint colors. Using observations, predictions, and "I wonder" statements, they began forming explanations based on trial and error.

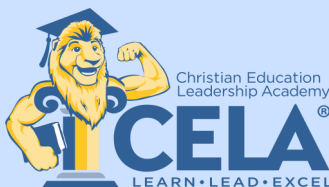
