

#### 5th Grade

The 5th graders completed a STEM project where they engineered a plan to help clean up a simulated oil spill. Students got to choose from a variety of items they could use to clean up the spill but were "charged" for each item used because cleaning up an oil spill can be very expensive. They had to keep track of the cost of each item, how long each item was used, and how effective each item was in the clean-up process. This project correlates with the 5th grade science standards of earth, human activity and engineering design.

The Leadership II class hosted Mr. Kraig Sorvick, the **Student Ministries Director at Meadowbrook Church** in Wauwatosa, WI. 




